

Suggested Segway Polo Equipment

Here is a list of materials for Segway Polo. Each player should purchase their own mallet. However, the team should purchase field equipment such as the cones, ball, and other optional equipment.

The sources listed are just for reference. Some of the 12-pack items may be more than you need (especially the referee pinnies—you probably only need 2). The practice vests are not needed if teams wear dark and light t-shirts.

The tall cones for the goals can be replaced by 36" long pvc pipe (driven into the ground) to be used as goal posts instead of the cones. But cones are safer since you can run over them. Technically in polo there's no upper limit on the goal height. The ball just has to go between the posts. Taller cones can also work well, but are more dangerous to run over.
